CODE OF CONDUCT

1. The entry forms, travel plan & student participation details and all other details must be filled in the link provided:

2. Spot entry/ changes will not be permitted.

3. No accomodation will be provided at the school premises for those school who has not opted for it or not filled the google form (links given above). The google sheet details must be provided latest by **10 JULY 2025**, failing which, DPS Kollam will not be providing accomodation for the late team.
4. Each school should send one male staff member as a manager for boys and a female member as a manager with the girl's team. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
5. Consumption of liquor, drugs, tobacco and smoking is strictly prohibited during the conduct of the championship and stay in the school/ accommodation. Anyone who violates this rule will be immediately removed from the school campus and disciplinary action will be taken by the host school.
6. **Any damage done to the property of the school during the stay by participants will have to be compensated for, by the respective school.**
7. Participants are requested not to bring costly items such as Jewellery, mobile, camera, iPod and other electronic gadgets, as the use of these items is prohibited in campus. School will not be responsible for the loss of any articles during the stay.
8. It is compulsory for all the participants to attend the inaugural ceremony.
9. **List of things to be carried to the venue:**
 - a. *Attested Team Photo with the principal*
 - b. *Bonafide letter from the school Principal, with Seal and signature (original)*
 - c. *Entry Performa filled online, countersigned by the concerned Principal*
 - d. *All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player in original, shall be carried personally by the Team Manager, These documents may: include birth certificate/ Aadhaar Card*
 - e. *School Flag.*
 - f. *Toiletries other than mattress, buckets and mugs. (Mattress, buckets and mugs will be provided by the school.)*
 - g. *CBSE registration no for classes IX, X, XI,XII*
 - h. *The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal.*
10. As per CBSE guidelines Rs 500 will be charged per head per day for those who have opted for food and accommodation at the school premises.

11. Responsibilities of Team Manager/ Accompanying teacher

- a. Team Manager will be responsible for the conduct of the team on the field and in the school premises. Indiscipline by a student's/member will lead to disqualification and the students/member may be asked to leave the premises immediately. For violation of any rule or discipline, the participants will be disqualified. The decision of the officials & Jury is final and will be binding on the participants.*
- b. It is the responsibility of the team manager to bring the sick/ injured player to the First –Aid Committee*
- c. It is the responsibility of the team manager to coordinate with the teacher in-charge of the host school for meals and refreshments*
- d. Reporting at registration desk (at arrival) and departure desk(at departure time)*

12. Kindly note that no extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the teams. Only designated person by the school principal can accompanying the team in the school premises (authorization letter mandatory)

MEALS

For participating teams, breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner will be provided. Please pre-book your meals (google link attached above) to avoid any inconvenience.

Dinner	8.30 PM
1. Tea and snacks will be provided at a fixed venue & time in the morning and evening.	
2. Please note that each school will be assigned a designated counter or café to avail the service, and there will be no change in the meal venue allotted by the host school.	
3. Food coupons will be issued at the registration counters.	
4. Meals or food items should not be taken to the rooms (if applicable)	
5. All participants to retire to their allotted rooms after dinner.
